Notes & Quotes

- *Today's defeat was the worst ever for Georgia Southern, surpassing the previous worst, which was a 38-point loss in 1982. That game was GSU's fourth after restarting the football program.
- *GSU punter Terry Harvin had a punt blocked (partially) for only the second time in his career. The first time came in his first game at GSU, in 1987 vs. Central Fla.
- *The 64 yards gained by Georgia Southern in the first half was the lowest total ever, a school-record low.
- *Lawrence Dawsey has now caught a pass in 23 straight games. (FSU)
- *FSU receiver Shannon Baker's second-quarter TD catch was the first of his career.
- *FSU running back Sean Jackson's 51-yard run marked the longest run from scrimmage by an FSU RB since the Michigan State game of 1988 (9/24). In that game, Keith Ross had a 53-yard run. The longest rush of 1989 was a 37-yard TD run by Dexter Carter.
- *Florida State rushed for over 200-yards (team) for the second consecutive game for the first time since 1988, when FSU gained over 200 yards rushing in each of the last three games.
- *Terrell Buckley's second punt return for a touchdown in as many games marked the first time in FSU history anyone has received punts and returned them in consecutive games for TDs. In 1984, Joe Wessel returned blocked punts for touchdowns in consecutive games vs. Tulane and Arizona State.

Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden

"We played much better than last week, but remember, we haven't played a major foe yet. Give Georgia Southern credit, they never quit. We had too many players. They knew that. They had some talented kids, we just had more. We are not there yet. We definitely need work. Our schedule is giving us what we need. We don't need any of those top threes yet. I thought Brad (Johnson) played well. And I was glad we gave Casey and Kenny Felder some work. Sean Jackson played real well. He looked great tonight. Richie Andrews is kicking great, the kicking game was better tonight. We finally got Buckley a return. He kept calling for fair catches. I've got to talk to him about that (ha-ha). Our defense was strong. We played the option about as well as we could have. I think we'll see it next week too. We played more people this week and that is always good."

Georgia Southern Head Coach Tim Stowers

"Well, I didn't see anybody quit, and that's a positive... That's a thing we can build on... The thing that bothers me is that we can move the sticks if we can just execute our offense, and we're so far from executing our base play, the triple option, that we have to go back next week and get better running the inside veer... We've got to if we're gonna have a chance to beat Eastern Kentucky

(On the backward lateral)... One of their defensive linemen got penetration and ran our offense into the backfield... The quarterback was hit and it was a lateral... The play was an inside hitch... I guess I just didn't do a good job coaching... We have to get on the ball if that's a lateral... That's one thing to work on next week...
