NOTES & QUOTES

- *** Amp Lee's first-quarter TD was his third of the year and 22nd rushing TD of his career. That ranks third on the FSU career list. He needs two more to tie Dayne Williams for 2nd. Lee's 162 career scoring total is sixth on the FSU career list, two points behind Barry Smith's fifth place total.
- *** Saturday night was a night of "firsts" for many of Florida State's young players. William Floyd, Tiger McMillon and Marquette Smith each scored their first collegiate touchdowns while Kenny Felder threw his first TD pass as a Seminole. Mack Knight picked off his first career pass. Also, WR Matt Frier caught his first pass of the season.
- *** Florida State dressed 101 players for the contest and used 77. Western Michigan dressed 50.
- *** The shutout was FSU's first since 1988 when the Seminoles defeated South Carolina 59-0 in Columbia. Florida State's last shutout at home came in the 1986 season opener when the Seminoles beat another MAC opponent, Toledo, 24-0.
- *** FSU has now won nine straight games dating back to last year's Auburn game and has a home winning streak of 13 in home contests.
- *** Western Michigan suffered its worst loss in school history with the 58-0 defeat. WMU's previous worst loss was a 67-12 defeat at the hands of Ohio in 1953.
- *** HEAD COACH BOBBY BOWDEN, FSU:
- "Western Michigan was really out-manned. We knew going in that we had every advantage, but they never let up, they never quit fighting. My hat's off to them. Their coach told me they didn't have any injuries and I'm glad for that.
- "Our second team offensive line played the whole second half. I'm happy that they did well. This is the first time we've been able to move the ball behind them.
- "I thought all of the reserves did a good job tonight. It's hard to move the ball when you just about quit throwing.
- "Our defense was excellent. I was glad we got some turnovers. This is our first shutout in a while. You can't arrive at anything on our number one status tonight. I really don't think we lost any ground.
- "I don't know if we're ready for Michigan yet, but I hope to be in two weeks. Their win and our win sets up what might be the game of the year. They had a mighty big win today. I don't think my kids will have any problem getting ready to play Michigan at Michigan. My biggest fear tonight was looking ahead and we did not."
- *** FSU gave up only 44 rushing yards tonight and has sacrificed only 146 yards in three games this season. FSU opponents are averaging only 48.7 yards per game on the ground.
- *** WESTERN MICHIGAN HEAD COACH AL MOLDE:
- "Florida State is a great team. They totally outclassed us. (Bobby) Bowden treated us well. He substituted freely. We didn't play as well as we can. We are looking forward to next week's important league game with Toledo. We have to get our team back to where it's ready to do that. We wanted to come in here and accomplish some things, I doubt that we did that. Again, Florida State is tremendous and I wish them luck with the rest of their schedule."
