Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden:

"Credit Middle Tennessee State for this game. They really took it to us. Coach Donnelly had 'em better prepared than our kids. I expected to just physically dominate them up front. We didn't even come close to doing that. That quarterback was really good, wasn't he? And man, that 21 could really run.

"I'll tell you this, if we don't get better next week, we will lose. Our offensive line really got whipped today. This is the first time in a while, we just couldn't knock the ball into the end zone. We'll just go back into pads next week and try to get it back. I'm not really frustrated, because kids won't play great every week. A lot of it depends on who you're playing. I'm not worried too much about this, because I think we'll bounce back against LSU. We had more talent today and that's why we won. It had nothing to do with coaching. I called all the plays in the second half and to be honest, things didn't get any better, did they? We just really didn't execute today. We had lots of opportunities and let them get away. The thing is, the biggest stat went to us and that is a W. We're 7-0 so you can't be disappointed with that."

Middle Tennessee State Head Coach Boots Donnelly:

"I couldn't be prouder of the way our guys stayed in the fight . . . we came down here, not really concerned that much about the score. We had no illusions about being able to upset the No. 1 team in the country.

"We just wanted to play the game one snap at a time and see how long we could stay with 'em. We did that for a half, but by then I think the numbers have some effect on us and I thought maybe I could see the energy draining through our shoes during the ~~20-minute~~ 20-minute intermission.

"We played very well, particularly into the early part of the third quarter. We could never really get Florida State's ~~offense~~ offense stopped -- early or late. That quarterback of theirs is really something. He made some really big plays, it seemed to keep almost every drive alive at a critical time. And their running backs did a great job, too.

"One thing everybody needs to understand, too. Florida State was not 'up' for this game. There was no need for them to turn back-flips over playing us. But they did a workmanlike job and they got it done.

"We need to enjoy this one right now, the feeling that we were able to stand up and take the best the country had to offer for quite a while. But we have to go back home and get ready to play a Conference game next week. We don't have the luxury of being able to dwell on whatever good there was that happened here.

"But I think we're going home with the respect of the Florida State coaching staff and players -- and maybe a little more respect for ourselves."
