GEORGIA TECH POST-GAME NOTES

*By marching 80 yards for a touchdown on its opening drive, Georgia Tech became the first school to score on Florida State on its opening drive this season. The Yellow Jackets went 80 yards in 18 plays on their first possession which was capped off by Phillip Rogers' 2-yard scoring run.

*Junior tailback Phillip Rogers' 2-yard touchdown run in the first quarter was his first rushing touchdown of the season and sixth of his career.

*Georgia Tech's seven points tonight was the lowest point total of the season for the Yellow Jackets and their lowest point production since getting shutout by Florida State last October 18 in Tallahassee by a score of 38-0.

*The Yellow Jackets had their string of 40-point scoring games snapped at five. Georgia Tech entered tonight's contest having scored 40 or more points in its last five outings dating back to this year's New Mexico State game on Sept. 12. The Jackets also scored 40 or more points against North Carolina, Duke, N.C. State and Virginia.

*The Yellow Jackets also saw a string of 20-plus point scoring games come to an end tonight. Entering the game, Tech had scored 20 or more points in 11 straight games, dating back to last year's 35-31 loss to Virginia. To find a similar streak, one must go all the way back to 1918, when the Jackets scored 20 or more points in 16 straight contests in the 1916, 1917 and 1918 seasons.

* Georgia Tech had its string of defensive touchdowns scored in a game end at five. Before tonight, Georgia Tech set an NCAA-record with five fumble returns for touchdowns in a season. Tech's streak began with the New Mexico State game. The Jackets also scored on fumble returns against North Carolina, Duke, N.C. State and Virginia.

*The last time Georgia Tech was shutout in a half came in last year's 38-0 loss to Florida State. The Jackets were held scoreless in the second half tonight.

*Tonight's attendance of 46,362 was the largest crowd since the stadium's seating capacity was reduced in 1986 to 46,000.

*The Georgia Tech Sports Information Office issued a total of 566 press credentials for tonight's game.

HEAD COACH GEORGE O'LEARY

"It's very obvious that you can't beat a team like Florida State when you turn it over six times. The first half I thought we had some opportunities. In the second half, the turnovers hurt us from a field position standpoint, and give credit to Florida State. They did something with the turnovers. You can't do that against a good football team and expect to be in the game. I thought defensively we hung in there until the third or fourth turnover and then we wore down a little bit. Give credit to Florida State, they came out and caused some turnovers and did something with them. That was the difference. We didn't get anything done offensively in the second half, and the Florida State defense had a lot to do with that.

"Hamilton just has a hip pointer. He should be fine

"The first half, we did some good things on the first drive. We just can't turn it over like that against a team like and expect to compete. We had chances and we didn't take advantage of them. Then in the second half, their speed showed. We didn't make plays, and give credit to them, they have a lot of good athletes.

"I think we did a good job on defense tonight. We've just got to get both sides of the ball clicking at the same time. Offensively, I thought we fought hard, but FSU had a good game. "I'm going to quit thinking about this game tomorrow. I think we're still in a good place in the ACC, and we're still in a three-way tie (for the conference lead) with Virginia and Florida State. As long as we win the rest of our ACC games, that's all we can do."

On Florida State's offense

"Florida State's offense, to me, they just rely on their athletes. They don't have a great scheme or anything, they just kind of play pitch and catch with people who are going to be first-round draft picks. You keep coming at them, and all of a sudden they pop a big one on you. The stuff they do, most teams don't have plays like that. That's just how they do it. It's not like their offense is so great. They just have great players."

Phillip Rogers, Junior Tailback

"It was a big adversity when Joe (Hamilton) went out of the game. We knew going into the game, that everything wasn't going to go perfect, but I think we could have bounced back from that down 10-7, but we didn't. We just turned the ball over too many times. We've just got to win the rest of our games. We've got to win."

On Florida State's defense

"I believe they're comparable to Virginia. They have more speed than Virginia, but between them and Virginia, they are the toughest defense we've faced."

Jesse Tarplin, Senior Defensive End

"We took away the run in the first half for the most part., which made them go to a passing game. We already figured out from watching film on them this week that we could exploit their offensive line with our pass rush. Virginia by far was the best offense we've faced all year, but Florida State has some athletes out there. We've got to give them credit for that. The end result was disappointing, because we came out at halftime and felt like we still had a chance to win the game. We just turned the ball over. We had too many fumbles. All we can do right now is look forward to Maryland next week. We've got to bounce back and keep going for the race in the ACC. We've still got a shot, but all we can do is take care of what we can."

FINAL GAME NOTES

- With his 21st career TD catch in the fourth quarter, Peter Warrick tied Jessie Hester (81-84) for fifth on the FSU career list. It is the seventh game this season that Warrick has caught a TD pass and second of the year with more than one TD catch. He is also tied with Hester and Lawrence Dawsey on the single-season FSU list with nine TD catches. Warrick also moved up to sixth place on the FSU career receiving yards list passing Lawrence Dawsey (87-90) with 2,219 yards with 2,206.
- Warrick's three touchdowns tonight (1 rush, 2 receiving) is a career high.
- Laveranues Coles' 60-yard TD run is also the longest run by an FSU player this season and Coles' career-long.
- Tonight QB Chris Weinke became just the 12th FSU quarterback to pass for over 2,000 yards in a single-season and did it in only eight games. Weinke now ranks 12th on the FSU single season passing yardage list with 2,006 yards.
- Weinke has now attempted 175 consecutive passes without an interception. Since throwing six interceptions at NC State, Weinke has thrown for 14 TD and no interceptions. He is also still the only quarterback in the ACC to have thrown for 200 yards or more in every game this season (which is just one game short of tying the FSU single season record). His 65.3 (17-for-26) completion percentage tonight is his best of the season.
- Florida State has held Georgia Tech to 10 or fewer points in each of the last six meetings. The Seminoles have outscored 255-30 over the last six meetings of the series.
- With 167 career points, Sebastian Janikowski is now ninth on the FSU career scoring list.
- Florida State has held six of its eight opponents to less than 120 yards passing after allowing just 119 yards by the Yellow Jackets.
- The Seminoles are now 31-10-1 against opponents ranked in the AP Top 20 during the 1990s. FSU has three of those wins this season (#15 Texas A&M, #18 USC, and #20 Ga. Tech).

Florida State Head Coach Bobby Bowden

Comments on Georgia Tech overall:

"They play really good. If it weren't for Joe Hamilton getting hurt in the game, no telling what could have happened. Our offense answered despite themselves. It seems like it was taking us five downs just to make a first down."

"Georgia Tech really had everything going for them. The momentum was on their side and they had the crowd really involved."

Bowden on Florida State defense:

"Defense played really good. I was concerned about number 22 (Dez White). He is just a super player. Tonight we were able to handle him and shut him down."

Bowden on Weinke:

"Weinke was the key to our win. He made the big plays. He has really picked up his game since the NC State loss. He has gone six games without an interception since that game."

Bowden on the difference in the game:

"I think the difference was that they probably got tired. We played more people than they did. I think that became a big factor. Like I said early, if Hamilton would not have gotten injured, no telling what could have happened."

"The big difference was when we recovered the fumble and was able to score. I think that was a big momentum swing."

PETER WARRICK, WIDE RECEIVER

"(on reverse TD) I gave the defender what we call an "Amp Lee move". It took a little while for us to get going tonight, but eventually we did. Chris Weinke played well and put the ball where it had to be. He continues to make big plays. We stepped it up when we had to. This game puts us in the driver's seat for the ACC title. We just have to keep playing like we are and not let up.

CHRIS WEINKE

"This is a good Georgia Tech team we beat tonight. This is a team that beat NC State, so we had even more to prove tonight. This is a big win for us in terms of the conference and I felt like we needed to come up here and play with some enthusiasm. This team has really come together since the NC State loss."

COREY SIMON

"I knew we could play the way we did once we settled down and played our style of defense. They did some good things offensively on that first drive. It shows the character we have on defense, the way we responded. Ever since the NC State game, we've come together and started to play football as a team. (on caused fumble) "I didn't know he fumbled it when I hit him. I guess the ball popped loose when I hit him and Dexter (Jackson) recovered it. That's what this team is all about -- making big plays like that.

TAY CODY

"I give them credit on that first drive. They did a lot of things we didn't expect. After that drive, we made some minor adjustments and shut them down. We just wanted to come out and play Seminole football. We wanted to come out and challenge them and make them beat us. It's very hard to move the ball when we play our game. I thought we played pretty good in the secondary. They had some very talented receivers and we took that on as a challenge."
