

Florida State's first cross-country team opens its season here Saturday against the University of Miami.

The meet, first of four dual events this year for FSU, will be run at 10 a. m. on a newly-constructed course near the old Municipal Airport.

Coaching the team is assistant track coach Verlyn Giles.

After the Miami meet, FSU will host Troy (Ala.) State College on Nov. 7, travel to the University of Florida on Nov. 12 and then play host to Florida on Dec. 1. To end the season, they'll enter an AAU meet in Troy, Ala., on Dec. 8.

FSU's freshman team will run the same schedule as the varsity.
