

Florida Takes Cross Country Run From FSU

GAINESVILLE (AP) — Charles Goodyear set a school record yesterday in leading Florida's cross country team to a 19-36 victory over Florida State.

Goodyear ran the four-mile course in 22 minutes 39.4 seconds.

This bettered the 23:20.0 previous record held by Tom Harrell, who ran second to Goodyear yesterday in 23:30.2.

The next two finishers also were from Florida, Bill Opperman running third and Austin Funk fourth.

FSU's Dick Roberts was best for the Seminoles. He finished fifth in 24:12.8.
