

## FSU Harriers Capture State College Crown

Florida State won the first intercollegiate state cross-country championship Saturday at the University of Florida course with a score of 28 points.

Next year's event will be in Miami.

Miami was second with 42 points, Florida third with 58 and South Florida fourth with 90. Florida Presbyterian had an entry but not a full team.

FSU's Tom Graham won with a time of 20:18.8, a new UF course and varsity mark. Ed Tyers, Miami, was second; Bill Nelson, FSU, third; Chris Quimby, Miami, fourth; and Dieter Gebhard, UF, fifth.

Florida took the frosh event with 23 points to 45 for FSU. Miami also took part but did not have a full team.
