FSU Outruns UF and Rest Of the Field

GAINESVILLE — Florida State's cross - country team captured three of the top five spaces plus the team championship at the Florida Invitational Intercollegiate here Saturday morning.

The Seminoles' Bobby Brooks out - distanced Florida's Brian Quinn for individual honors, covering the new five mile layout in 25:17 for a course record in collegiate.

Quinn covered the distance in 25:35, just ahead of FSU's Del Ramers, who placed third.

Bobby James was fifth for the Seminoles, Bobby Burr was 11th and Tim Simpkins 20th, giving the Tribe a total of 20 points - seven more than second - place Auburn. The Tigers top four runners were seventh, eighth, ninth and 10th.

The meet was run concurrently with an individual opendivision field, won by Barry Brown of the Florida Track Club. Former Florida State All - American Ken Misner was second.
