Florida State's cross - country team will get its first action of the new season today in the South Alabama Invitational at Mobile.

PSU runners are the defending champions in this five mile run, beating out Alabama last year. Once again Coach Dick Roberts expects the toughest competition to come from Alabama, Auburn and host University of South Alabama.

"This is our first meet as a team," said Roberts, "and we are looking forward to it. Our early workouts have been very encouraging."

Depth would appear to be the big key. The Seminoles will go into the season with just one veteran senior on the squad.

"We appear to have more depth than at any time in the past," said Roberts. "We will go into this meet with five runmers who should all finish in close proximity to each other and be well up near the front."

Cook, a freshman, was the Florida 4-A high school champion last spring. West, a junior, was the runnerup in the National JC mile last season.

Coxwell is another JC transfer coming over from Lake City, where he was the leading cross - country runner in the state two years ago. He was out of action last year, slowed by illness, but is reported back in top condition now. O'Brien is a sophomore who returns to Florida State after two years in the service, and he has been "a pleasant surprise," according to Roberts.

Cook and West are the only two Seminoles to have seen any action this season, running in last week's Stone Mountain Road Race near Atlanta where they finished 8th and 11th overall and 4th and 7th among collegiate runners.
