

FSU wins opener in cross-country

MACON, Ga. — Florida State's cross-country team opened its season Monday with a victory in the Macon Telegraph and News road race.

FSU senior Herb Wills was the individual winner, finishing ahead of 1,200 other runners in 29:59.7. Scott Taylor finished fourth in 30:48, Ronnie Treadway fifth in 31:10, Jessie Close eighth in 31:18 and Clay McLeod 15th in 32:29.

Competing for the the Florida State Track Club, Mike Yarbrough finished ninth in 31:26 and Mark Trigg 22nd in 32:50.

The Seminoles will compete in a meet Saturday at 9 a.m. at the FSU golf course.
