

Seminole men win cross country

The FSU men's cross country team

won the Furman Invitational Saturday in Greenville, S.C.

FSU finished atop a field of fifteen teams by placing three runners among the top 10.

Philip Rolle paced the Seminoles, placing third overall and finishing the 10,000-meter course in 31:16.

Ronnie Treadway was fifth with a time of 31:32, and Paul Waldron was eighth at 32:09.

FSU's next meet is the Florida Invitational in Gainesville, Oct. 23.
