

FSU Linksmen In State Meet; Top Georgia

FSU Golf Coach Bob Harbison and five Seminole links stars left this morning for DeLand, where the team will compete in the second annual state inter-collegiate tournament.

Members of the FSU team making the trip are defending state intercollegiate champion, Sonny Tinney, Joe Bassett, Hank Mercer, Ted Hewitt and Dick Montney.

The Seminoles opened their 1949 season at the Country club course yesterday by squeezing out a 14-13 victory over the University of Georgia Bulldogs.

Results of the matches with individual players' medal score were: (FSU players named first).

Ted Hewitt (76) over Jack Gray (78), two points to one; Dick Montney (76) over Wilkens Kirby (83), 3-0; Hewitt and Montney over Kirby and Gray, 3-0.

Sonny Tinney (81) lost to Harold Spears (74), 0-3; Joe Bassett (79) lost to Buddy Smith (76), $\frac{1}{2}$ -2 $\frac{1}{2}$; Tinney and Bassett lost to Sears and Smith, 0-3.
