

FSU GOLFERS THUMP MOCS

Score 17-1 Win To Stay Unbeaten

Florida State University's golf squad continued its unbeaten march here yesterday afternoon, scoring a decisive 17-1 victory over the Southern College Mocs from Lakeland.

The win gave Coach Bob Harrison's linksmen a clean sweep over their Dixie Conference rivals. FSU had won the opening match of the weekend series 12-5 Friday.

Ted Hewitt, the Seminoles' all-around athletic ace, birdied four of the last five holes to fire a par 72 and take medalist honors in the meet.

Jimmy James was a stroke back of Hewitt with a one-over-par 73. Southern Picked up a half point in two of the singles matches to avoid being blanked over the rolling Country club course.
