

FSU-Rollins Golfers Battle To 9-9 Tie

Jimmy James, slender sharp-shooter from Tallahassee, came through with a birdie three on the final hole of the match to defeat Billy Key of Rollins College one-up and give the Florida State University Seminoles a 9-9 tie with the Tars here yesterday.

The deadlock preserved Florida State's undefeated record, the Seminoles having won their four previous matches this season.

All the other matches were settled and FSU trailed Rollins by one point as James and Key teed off on the 18th hole. Both drives made the green, but James got his chance when Key's approach putt rolled six feet beyond the cup. The dark haired Tallahasseean knocked his second shot within 12 inches of the flag, then dropped it for his winning birdie after Key missed his 8-footer.

James had the low medal score of the afternoon, an even-par 72. Joe Bassett of Florida State and Key had 73's for runnerup honors.
