

## Montney Paces FSU Golfers To Victory

Paced by Dick Montney who fired a two-under-par 70, the Florida State University golf team continued its undefeated march here yesterday afternoon with an 18½-8½ victory over Stetson at the Country Club course.

Montney's sub-par round, which included four birdies, enabled him to sweep three points from the Hatters Ed Reaves.

Joe Bassett, FSU also broke par, firing a one-under 71 to blank Bill Herman.

Ted Hewitt, who had trouble with his putting, had a par 72 and won three points from Alex Pirie.

Bill Rice of the Seminoles scored a fine eagle two on the par four seventh hole with his tee shot and a wedge.

The win was FSU's fifth of the season without a loss. They were tied by Rollins 9-9 for the only blot on their slate.
