

# Dixie Conference Spring Championships

MACON, Ga., May 20 — The Florida State University Seminoles ran their string of Dixie Conference championships to five here today as they scored easy victories in golf, tennis and track.

The Indians, who had previously copped the conference crowns in football and baseball, experienced little trouble in golf and tennis but were forced to extend their best efforts to beat out a tough Mercer track team.

The golfers won over second place Mercer University of Macon by an unbelievable 77 strokes (64 holes medal play, four-man teams). And the netters trimmed Florida Southern College of Lakeland, the nearest opponent, 19-11.

The Florida State track team found the going much tougher, winning with 71 points to 61½ for Mercer, 43 7/10 for Mississippi College and 38 1/5 for Florida Southern.

## Individual Honors

Individual tennis honors were taken by Herb Quay of FSU in the Class B singles, Bob Lanigan of FSU in Class C singles, Quay and Don Seiffert in the doubles. George Winchell of Florida Southern successfully defended his Class A singles crown by edging Seiffert of the Indians in a three-set match.

Sonny Tinney of Florida State set a new medal score record in defending his individual Dixie Conference golf title. The lanky Tallahasseean, who only three weeks ago got back on the links after being out of action all season with a broken wrist, negotiated the tournament's 54 holes in 214 strokes—two under par for the course. He was followed in order by three of his teammates: Dick Montney—218, Ted Hewitt—226, Joe Bassett—231.

Florida Southern's team dropped out of the tournament before completing the initial 36 holes.

## Nip and Tuck

The track meet was a nip and tuck battle all the way with Bob Reeder of Mercer and Tom Bowman of Florida State battling it out for individual honors. Reeder took the cup with four first places and a final total of 20¾ points to Bowman's 20¾.
