DELAND, Mar. 10 — Florida State University's golf squad scored its first victory of the young season here today, a smashing 16-2 triumph over the Stetson Hatters.

The Seminoles, who had been held to a 9-9 tie by Rollins in their season opener Friday, were paced today by Ted Hewitt's fine 70 which won medal honors for the day.

Hewitt's 70 enabled him to win 2½ of the possible three points from Hatter star Chuck Rea, who was low for Stetson with a 75.

The scoring summary with the players, points won and medal scores indicated is as follows: Hewitt, FSU, 2½, 70, defeated Rea, Stetson, 1½, 75. Eddie Johnson, FSU, 2, 78, defeated Price Bush, 1, 83. Dick Montney, FSU, 3, 73, defeated Guido Tambur, 0, 82. Tom Cumbie, 2½, 77, defeated George Frison, 1½, 84.

Hewitt and Johnson defeated Rea and Bush to sweep 3 points and Montney and Cumbie blanked Tambur and Frison.
