

FSU Golfers Blast Georgia

Paced by veteran Dick Montney's even par 72, the Florida State University golf team defeated the University of Georgia linksmen 25-2 here yesterday afternoon. It was the second victory of the season for the Seminoles, along with a tie.

Montney had a nightmarish round in spite of his fine score, turning in 7 birdies for the 18 holes and scrambling the rest of the way. Eddie Johnson, Tallahassee freshman, chalked up a 73 for the Seminoles and Letterman Ted Hewitt had a 74. Griffin Moody was low man for Georgia with a 75.

Florida State Coach Bob Harbison will take six players to Deland today where the Seminoles are scheduled to participate in the State Intercollegiate tournament tomorrow, Friday and Saturday. Making the trip will be lettermen Hewitt and Montney, and new team members Johnson, Tommy Brown, Tom Cumble and Bud Marsee.
