

Florida State University's golf team is scheduled to battle the Emory University linksmen tomorrow afternoon on the Tallahassee Country Club course after having trounced Mercer's Bears 17½-½ yesterday afternoon.

The victory gives Coach Bob Harbison's Seminole golfers a season mark of three victories, two losses, and one tie.

Florida State's Dick Montney, a two year letterman from Detroit, took medal honors in yesterday's match with a two under par 70. Eddie Johnson, former Leon high school ace, followed with a 71.

Harry Bloon saved the Georgia outfit from being shutout by the strong Tribe golf squad when he salvaged a half point from Johnson. Bloon led the Mercer medal score with a five over par 77.
