Georgia Tops FSU, 24-3

ATHENS, May 4—Three Bulldogs broke par here Friday afternoon as the Georgia golf team defeated Florida State University 23-4, for its ninth consecutive victory. The win avenged an earlier loss to FSU this season.

Marvin (Red) Hester fired a two-under-par 70, and Captain Wilkins Kirby and Griffin Moody posted one-under-par scores of 71.

Georgia meets the University of Florida here Tuesday in the final match before the annual Southern Intercollegiate tournament.

Summary:
