

FSU Linksmen Blast Mercer

MACON, Ga. — Florida State University's linksmen got back on the winning side yesterday with a 19 to 8 win over Mercer University, paced by the one under par 71 shotmaking of Eddie Johnson.

For Coach Bob Harbison's golfers, the win was number seven against three losses and a tie.
