

Seminoles Cop Tuneup Match For Southern

ATHENS, GA. — The Florida State University golf team defeated Emory University here 10-8 yesterday afternoon in a tune-up match for the Southern Inter-collegiate tournament which gets under way today.

The Emory match had been postponed from an earlier date. The victory ran the Seminoles' season record to eight wins, three defeats and a tie.

Tom Cumbie, fast improving shotmaker from Quincy, paced the Seminoles in yesterday's victory over Emory, taking 2½ points from his opponent with a one-over-par 73.

WON'T DEFEND DIXIE

Florida State Coach Bob Harbison announced just before his players teed off in the Southern Inter-collegiate this morning that the Seminoles would not defend their Dixie Conference title at Clinton, Miss. next week. Harbison gave "lack of funds" as the reason for not making the trip to Clinton.
