

FSU Golfers Beat Miami In Warmup

DELAND—Warming up for today's first shot at the Florida Intercollegiate golf tourney title, Florida State University's links team defeated Miami's Hurricanes 11½ to 5½ over the College Arms course yesterday.

Seminole star Robert "Sonny" Tinney, one of the ranking favorites for the individual crown, took the College Arms course—site of the meet—apart with a sizzling 69 to pace the triumph yesterday.

Tinney defeated Benerden of Miami, 3-0. Benerden had a 74.

FSU's other leading title contender, Jimmy James, fired a 74 to defeat Ellis of Miami (76) 2-1.

Tom Cumble broke even with LaFrancis 1½-1½. Cumble had a 76, his foe a 76.

Tommy Brown, former Seminole football star, defeated Miles 2-1. Brown shot 78, Miles 80.

Frank Hirt defeated Crawford 2-1, as both of the players shot 84. Jude Dunfee bowed to Watts 2-1.
