

The Rollins College Tars swept all but one match here yesterday afternoon to defeat the Florida State University golf team 15½ to 2½.

The loss was Florida State's fourth in seven starts. The Seminoles will face the Mercer University Bears here in a match Saturday morning.

Jude Dunfee, husky Freshman sharpshooter from South Bend, Ind., saved the Seminoles from a complete whitewash yesterday when he took 2½ points from Larry Bently of the Tars. Dunfee had a 74, to Bently's 76.
