ATHENS, Ga. — Florida State University was scheduled to play an as yet unnamed foe in a final tuneup for the Southern Intercollegiate here today after losing a triangular golf meet to Alabama and Georgia yesterday.

The Seminoles lost to 'Bama 7½-4½ and Georgia 7-5, but FSU ace "Sonny" Tinney strengthened his ranking as one of the leading contenders for the Southern crown by taking medal honors with a 68 and defeating Tide and Bulldog aces.

Tinney defeated Moody (G) 3-0 and Hill (A) 2-1. Tommy Brown lost to Stevenson (G) 1-2 and McNelley (A) 1-2. Tom Cumbie lost to Kelly (G) 2½-½ and halved Straussburger (A) 1½ to 1½. Jude Dunfee lost to Hay (G) ½ to 2½ and Horton (A) 0-3.
