ATHENS, Ga. — Florida State University's Seminoles, who lost a final tune-up match to Auburn 10-8 yesterday in their final test tour of 5,800-yard County Club course here, moved into Southern Intercollegiate golf tourney play today tabbed as one of the dark-horse entries.

Heading the Seminole entries is Robert "Sunny" Tinney, expected to wage one of the leading fights for the title being defended by North Texas State's Billy Maxwell.

Tinney was upset yesterday by Skippy Weatherbee of Auburn, but lost little luster in his setback. The Auburn star beat Tinney 2-1 in point totals.

Other results of the Auburn match were: Tom Brown won over Fleming Norvell, 3-0; Tom Cumble halved Dick Howell, 1½-1½; Judge Dunfee lost to Al Morris, 1-2; Tinney and Brown halved Weatherbee and Norvell 1½-1½; Cumble and Dunfee lost to Howell and Morris, 0-3.
