

Florida State University's golfers elected Tom Cumble, Quincy, honorary captain for the 1952-season as the Seminoles closed their campaign with a 7½-4½ triumph over Jacksonville Navy.

Cumble, a junior, lettered as a sophomore on the fine 1951 team and is eligible to seek his third letter in the sport in '53.

The Jax Navy match, an abbreviated affair since the Fliers brought only a three-man team for the event, saw Robert "Sonny" Tinney pace the Indians to their triumph.

Tinney had the low medal for the day, a one-over-par 73, and swept his match with Jax's Ken Sutton, 3-0.

Cumble blanked Dave Moddy, 3-0, and Tommy Brown dropped a 2½-½ decision to Lou Chaff.

Jax won the team scoring 2-1. The triumph gave FSU an unofficial season mark of seven victories and eight defeats.
