

Florida State's golfers scored an easy 20-7 victory over Maxwell AFB here Friday afternoon, their second triumph of the young season.

FSU's Jack Veghte, the New York sophomore, won medal honors with a two-under-par 70. Close behind were Tallahassee's Bunk Berry and David Morris. The former Leon High ace both fired 72s.

Veghte, Morris, and Dick Huff were tops in individual team play. All recorded perfect 3-0 decisions over Air Force rivals. Huff had a 76.

Coach Don Veller, blessed with possibly FSU's best golf team, reports the race for team rankings is still in high gear. Veghte and Berry are battling for the No. 1 spot. Bobby Dunn, Billy Shelton, Huff, Morris, Bob Shuman, Norie Wright and Stan Ziebrovski are not far behind.
