

Sophomore Jack Veghte turned in the lowest competitive score of his collegiate career, a sparkling six-under-par 66, to lead Florida State's golfers to an easy 22-8 victory over Davidson College at Tallahassee Country Club yesterday.

It was the third straight triumph for Coach Don Veller's undefeated Seminoles, who host Auburn at TCC tomorrow.

A former New York state high school champion, Veghte put together a pair of 33s. Veghte missed a 65, two over the course record, when a three-foot putt failed to drop on the last green.

Veghte's opponent, Davidson's Al Gaither, also had a fine round, registering a 69.

Two other Seminoles matched or bettered par. Tallahassee's Bunk Berry fired a one-under 71 and Norris Wright, who has been troubled with an ear infection, had an even-par 72.
