

FSU Golfers Edge Georgia

Florida State's golfers came from behind on the last hole to cop their fifth win in six dual starts, 15-12, over the Georgia Bulldogs yesterday.

With FSU trailing, 10½-7½, sophomores Bunk Berry of Tallahassee and Jack Veghte of Gloversville, N. Y., birdied the last hole at Tallahassee Country Club for the Seminoles' margin of victory.

Seminole freshman Bobby Dunn of Camilla, Ga., last year's Georgia state high school champ, was medalist with a two-under-par 70.

Coach Don Veller said the Bulldogs were tougher than Georgia Tech.
