ATLANTA — Florida State's unbeaten golf team made a comeback on the final nine holes yesterday afternoon to edge Georgia Tech. 15½-11½.

The Seminoles avenged last year's meeting when Tech became the only team to whip Dr. Don Veller's team in 11 meets. And by coincidence, the score of FSU's win yesterday was the same by which Tech won last year.

Georgia Tech's Ned Edge was medalist for the day with a 68 on Atlanta's tough North Fulton course. Three FSU players—Ed Jenkins, Bobby Dunn, Billy Shelton—came in with 69's.
