GAINESVILLE — Florida State golfers swept their 2-match season's series from University of Florida, registering a 15-12 triumph yesterday on the Gators' home layout.

Six weeks ago, Dr. Don Veller's boys beat Florida, 22½-4½, in Tallahassee.

Though Florida's Dave Ragen set a course record for the Gainesville Country Club with a 10 under-par 62, the Seminole shot-makers were the picture of consistency as they overcame the Gators' halfway lead.

Ragan had five birdies and two eagles in posting his 33-29 effort.

Not a single Seminole went over 73 blows. Bobby Dunn, playing in the No. 1 slot, bowed to Ragen's record-breaking round in spite of his respectable two-under-par 70.

Other scores for FSU were Edwin Jenkins at 71, Bunk Berry, Billy Shelton and Harry Shoemaker at 72, and Jack Veghte with a 73.

The Tribe and Georgia stand in the way of a perfect season.

FSU also bested Florida this year in the Florida Intercollegiate Tournament.
