

Ed Jenkins fired a brilliant 5-under-par 65 yesterday to lead Florida State's golfers to a 25-2 exhibition victory over Wisconsin.

The junior from Jacksonville came within 3 strokes of tying for the third time his own record of 62 for the local Country Club course.

Though the victory won't go down in the books as a regular season triumph, it was the defending state intercollegiate champions' 18th in a row.

Two other FSU golfers, Bunk Berry of Tallahassee and Bob Shuman of Atlanta, carded 69s.

Jack Allen was the low man for Wisconsin with a 73.
