

Edwin Jenkins of Jacksonville and Bunk Berry of Tallahassee set the pace as Florida State University's golfers trounced the University of Miami, 23-4, here yesterday afternoon.

Jenkins toured the Capital City Country Club course in 70 strokes, two under par, for the day's lowest score. Berry fired a 71.

The victory pushed FSU's record to 5-1 for the season, with the lone loss at University of Florida hands.

Dr. Don Veller's Seminoles will meet Rollins at Winter Park Saturday, then seek revenge against Florida at Gainesville next Monday.
