

Reliable Bob Shave stroked a neat 68—four under par—to spark Florida State to a 21-6 golf victory over touring Georgia Tech at Capital City Country Club yesterday.

All six Seminoles came in ahead of their opponents to notch State's fourth dual triumph in six starts. It spoiled the season opener for the Yellow Jackets, who face Florida at Gainesville today.

Shave, veteran Seminole golfer from St. Petersburg, putted for a half-dozen birdies yesterday. Most of his iron shots were crisp and to the pin.
