

Bob Shave fired a two-under-par 70 yesterday to pace Florida State's golfers to a 17½ to 9½ victory over the University of Florida's state intercollegiate champions.

The victory gave the Seminoles some measure of revenge as they lost to Florida earlier in the year at Gainesville when the Gators fired four sub-par rounds. The victory upped State's dual record to five wins against two setbacks.
