

Bob Shave and Dink Wise carded 3-under-par 69s yesterday afternoon to pace Florida State's golfers to a 25½ to 1½ victory over Auburn.

After all FSU rounds were posted, the team total was 6-under-par with not a single FSU golfer needing more than 74 strokes to tour the Capital City Country Club course.

The performance was one of the Seminole's better ones this season and left them with a record of nine victories and four defeats. They will clash with Georgia Tech on Monday.
