

MIAMI (AP) — More than 100 golfers representing 13 colleges swarmed the Biltmore Course again today in the University of Miami - City of Coral Gables tournament.

Jim Peace, University of Miami sophomore, led opening day play with a one under par 70 to hold a two - stroke lead over Florida State's Downing Gray.

Florida State led in team play with 306, while Rollins had 310 and Miami's No. 1 team 311.

MIAMI (AP) — Today's 18 holes should tell the story in University of Miami's Intercollegiate Golf Tournament with eight players bunched close to the top.

Jim Peace of Miami led by a single stroke at the 54-hole mark, 70-78-76--224. His first round Thursday was one under par on the Biltmore course.

Packed behind Peace were Joe Eubank, Stetson, 225; George Stigger, Florida, 226; Bob Ross, Rollins, 227; Dick Guardiola, Miami, and Frank Beard, Florida, both with 229; and Frank Malara, Florida State and Jax Dolan, Rollins, with 230 each.

Rollins, defending champion, had a low 919 strokes at the 54-hole mark. University of Florida had 923 and Miami 932.

Florida State had been the first-day team leader but fell several strokes off the pace yesterday. Seminole sophomore Downing Gray was second low medalist in the opening round with a 72.

MIAMI — Rollins College easily won the team title of the University of Miami's invitational golf tournament here Saturday with a 1215 total, 19 strokes better than runner-up Florida and 20 in front of third-place FSU.

The Gators were at 1234, FSU had 1235.

George Stigger of Florida won the individual title after a play-off with Miami's Jim Peace. Both had 299 totals.

Other individual totals: Stetson's Jim Eubanks, 300; Rollins' Bob Ross, 300; Rollins' Bob Dolan, 302; FSU's Frank Malara, 303; FSU's Mel Fleischer, 306.

Fleischer had a 72 Saturday and Malara a 73. Other FSU last-day scores: Rem Noble, 78; Downing Gray, 74; Wayne Timberman, 75; Dickie Dunlap, 81.
