

ORLANDO —University of Florida defeated all opponents in rolling up a 5 and 0 victory to win the statewide collegiate golf round robin tournament which ended yesterday.

Medalist honors went to Mickey Van Gerbig of Rollins College, who carded a 73-78 — 151, one point better than the 73-79—152 carded by Lane Cobb of Florida Southern.

In the 36-hole Florida Inter-collegiate Conference competi-

tion, Rollins won the title with a team total of 639.

In second place, overall, was Miami with a round robin total of 4 and 1. Florida State was third with 3 and 2; Rollins fourth with 2 and 3; Florida Southern fifth with 1 and 4; and Stetson last with 0 and 5.

In the FIC tournament, Miami placed second with a team total third with 643; and Stetson was fourth with 679.

Chuck Keating was FSU's low scorer with 76-83 — 160.

UM Second In State Golf

ORLANDO — (AP) — Mickey Van Gerbig of Rollins College won medalist honors; Rollins won the Florida Intercollegiate Conference Golf championship, and Florida won the golf round robin tournament which ended Friday. Van Gerbig carded a 73-78—151.

Rollins carded a 639 team championship total. The University of Miami was second with 642. In winning the round robin, Florida turned in an undefeated 5 to 0 score. Miami was second with 4 and 1.
