

The Florida State golf team swept everything in sight yesterday at Capital City Country Club—defeating Georgia, Ga. Tech and Springfield (Mass.) College in varsity play and defeating Springfield and Ga. Tech in freshman competition.

The scores: FSU 14½ to 12½ over Georgia, 20-7 over Tech, 27-0 over Springfield in varsity play; 18-0 over Springfield and 19½-1½ over Tech among frosh.

It was a somewhat glamorous victory, since Georgia was ranked fourth nationally last year and the other two varsity teams are rated better than average.

Top score was turned in by FSU's Roger Kennedy, who carded a 70. Other FSU varsity scores: Dave Philo 71, Johnny Parsons 73, Mark Blair 74, Roy Beall 80 and David Lee 81. Frosh scores: Denny Lyons 71, Richie Karl 71, Bob Mielnikowski 72 and John Danielson 75.

Kennedy defeated Georgia's David Boyd, who was an All-American last Spring for the Bulldogs.
