

Greenwood Captures SIC Title

ATHENS, Ga. [AP] — Bobby Greenwood, senior from North Texas State, captured the Southern Intercollegiate Golf tournament Saturday with a 72-70 finish for a 287 total.

Breaking away from a tightly bunched field, Greenwood played steady golf over the 6,745-yard Athens Country Club Course. His total matched the previous high score of Dick Whetzle, a North Texas State player who won here in 1955.

Ken Folkes of Wake Forest, firing a final round 67, five under par, came from out of the scramble to gain a share of second place with Buddy McEwen of Memphis State and Jay Sigle of Wake Forest with 289. McEwen had led the field through 63 holes before hitting a bogey streak on the final four holes.

Rives McBee of North Texas State and Jack Oliver and Jimmy Gabrielsen of Georgia finished with 291. Oliver defeated Gabrielsen on the fourth hole of a play-off for the Southeastern Conference individual title.

Fred Marti of Houston and Jerry Potter of Miami were the next finishers with 292. Jimmy Allen of Georgia had 293 which gave the Bulldogs a 1-2-3 finish in the SEC.

Laurie Hammer of Florida, Gene Ferrell of LSU and Ken Lindsay of Memphis State finished with scores of 294.

At the end of 54 holes, Greenwood had a 217 which was two strokes behind McEwen. He overcame the deficit with a 34 on the outgoing nine, tying McEwen at 251 with nine holes to play. Greenwood bogied 12 and birdied 13 for a 36 windup while McEwen was taking bogies on three of the last four holes.

Folkes made a bid with a final nine of 32, scoring five birdies and two bogies. He birdied the last three holes.
