

GAINESVILLE— Florida State's golfers defeated the University of Florida for the second successive time here yesterday, 10-8.

The match wasn't won until the last hole when Bill Boutwell dropped a 20 foot putt to go two up on Florida's Murray Gay.

Florida's Dave Hamner took medalist honors with an even par 71, John Danielson was low for the Seminoles with a 72.

Strength down through the lineup provided the FSU victory. The number four, five and six players — Mark Blair, Danielson and Boutwell—each blanked their opponents, 3-0.

Number one man Denny Lyons lost to Hamner 3-0, but John Parsons and Richie Karl each won ½ point.

The Seminoles' record is now 2-0. Both victories have been at the expense of the Gators.

FSU's freshmen lost to the Florida Frosh, 9-3.
