

Miami Cops Golf Title

MIAMI (AP) — Paul Desjardins of the University of Miami won the individual championship and led his school to the team title of its own invitational golf tournament Saturday.

Desjardins shot a par 71 for a total 278, well ahead of Denny Lyons of Florida State University, second at 286.

They were followed by Jerry Potter, Miami, 290; Lauren Hammer, University of Florida, 291; and Ted Rowe, Miami, 291.

Miami won the team competition with 1,169, followed by Florida State, 1,178; University of Florida, 1,206; Rollins College, 1,209; and University of Michigan, 1,221.
