

Florida State's undefeated golfers warmed up for the Miami Invitational Tournament with a 15-3 victory over Georgia Tech here yesterday.

The match was closer than the score indicates. Number one man Denny Lyons and number six man Don Scartz won their matches going away, but there was no more than two strokes difference in medal scores in the middle of the order.

Lyons shot a 34-37-71 to defeat Tech's Bunky Henry who came in with an 82. Scartz had a 34-38-72.

The FSU freshmen experienced no difficulty, beating the Jacket fresh, 12-0. Hubert Greene was low with a 71.

The Florida State team's leaves today for the Miami Invitational, in which some of the top college golfers in the country are expected to participate.
