U-Florida's 'Find' Wins Golf Meet

Bob Murphy, a University of Florida junior, may be the most profitable find in golf since the electric caddy cart. Three years ago he was enrolled in Florida's Basic Golf course. Yesterday, Murphy won the University of Miami-Coral Gables Invitational tournament, scoring a two-under-par 69 for a 72-hole total 283.

Murphy's fast finish — he was under par the final 36 holes — enabled him to beat out team mate Laurie Hammer, 288, for the individual title. Florida took the first four places, with Wally Armstrong and Lloyd Watts tying for third at 291, to win the team trophy in a record 1,157. Florida State was second, 1,187, while host Miami was fifth, 1,217.

SWING'S THE THING

Murphy landed on the Florida golf team quite incidentally. He was spotted in a Basic Golf class, a physical education course for beginners, by Coach Buster Bishop. "It was his swing," said Bishop. "He has an outstanding swing."
