CAPE CORAL. — Florida State's golfers placed four men in the top eight positions to take a three stroke victory over the University of Florida in the Florida Intercollegiate Tournament here yesterday.

FSU's Denny Lyons relinquished medalist honors to Florida's Bob Murphy, but Bill Boutwell, Carl DiCesare and Jay Morelli finished third, sixth and eighth to win for the Seminoles.

Murphy, last year's national amateur champion, started the day one stroke behind FSU's Boutwell and one stroke up on Lyons. He cruised the final 18 in a two-under-par 70 to finish with a 54 hole total of 216.

Lyons, the opening round leader had a 74 for a 221 total and Boutwell finished one stroke off at 222.

Florida's Dave Oakley was fourth with a 224 total.

FSU's Jimmy Duval competed individually and finished fifth with a 225 total which did not count in team standings.

Other Florida State scores were DiCesare 227, Merelli, 229. Chip Romano, 236, and Hubert Green, 240.
