Florida State's golf team yesterday won its third straight golf match, downing Ball State 14-4 at the FSU course.

Sophomore Carl DiCesare, a former New York state champion, had the best round on the windy course, a 73. FSU's top golfers, Bill Boutwell and Denny Lyons, shot 74 and 75.

Last weekend the Seminoles, who are state champions thanks to their victory in the Cape Coral Florida Intercollegiates, won twice and tied Florida 12-12.
