

FSU Golfers Are Second

MOBILE, Ala. — Florida State's golf team finished second to Alabama in the annual Senior Bowl Tournament. Florida was third in the 12-team field.

For the 36 holes of action, Alabama had a total team score of 739, compared with Florida State's 756 and Florida's 760.

Following, in order, were LSU of New Orleans (675), Tennessee (768), Miami (770), Georgia Tech (783), Auburn (785), Southern Mississippi (792), Tennessee Tech (793), Kentucky (797), South Alabama (799) and Tulane (816).

FSU's Ben Voyles was fourth in the contention for individual honors with 73-73—146. Alabama's Clyde McLendon and Lee Harper were one-two with 143 and 144 while Florida's Steve Morgan was third at 145.
