HOLLYWOOD — Florida State University, led by medalist Mark Alwin's finalround 71, closed with a 284 team total, four under par, Tuesday to wrest the Biscayne College Golf Classic title from third-round leader University of Miami at Hollywood Lakes Country Club.

Miami, with a six-shot lead over the Seminoles entering the final round, skied to a 297 team total and finished second with 1,165, five strokes ahead of University of South Florida, but seven off FSU's 1,158 pace.
