Florida Coasts Home At Mobile

MOBILE, Ala. (AP) — The University of Florida, led by individual champion Andy Bean, coasted home to an 11-stroke margin in the finals of the Senior Bowl Golf Tournament Friday.

Bean carded the tournament's only subpar round, a two-under 70, for a 76-70—146 for the 36-hole meet. He ended up three strokes under Thursday's leader, Micky Mabry of Tennessee, who was runnerup with 74-75—149.

Other individual leaders were Rick Gaille, Louisiana State of New Orleans, 77-73—150; Walter Verneuille, Auburn, 76-75—151; Jimmy Smith, Florida, 76-75—151; Alan Guyton, Georgia Tech, 77-75—152; and John O'Neill, Alabama, 78-75—153.

The team victory was the third for Florida during the past four years. The Gators wound up with a team total of 761, and LSU-NO was runnerup at 772. Defending champion Alabama was third at 776.

Other team totals: South Florida 783, Auburn 787, Florida State 788, Georgia Tech 790, Tennessee 791, Southern Mississippi 810, South Alabama 823, and Spring Hill 852.
